CANOPY SCOTTSDALE

What's old is new again, at least in Old Town where Canopy Scottsdale enjoys the distinction of being the first new hotel to open in over a decade. Tucked away among galleries, the modern hotel resides across the street from Western Spirit: Scottsdale's Museum of the West. It's one of a handful of buildings where the contemporary aesthetic balances Old Town's penchant for low-slung buildings and Old West styling. The resulting blend of Southwestern heritage and modern aesthetics defines the hotel, from the colors (crimson, gold and gray) and materials (local stone, tile, wood and copper) to artful architectural touches, like floating ceiling panels and floor-to-ceiling windows. Designer Kellie Sirna of Studio 11 Design points to the collection of Barry Goldwater photographs on display, noting the hotel is "a showcase for Scottsdale's creative community." You don't have to be a creative, however, to appreciate the hotel's 177 guest rooms, cozy lobby library and serene rooftop lounge where sunset views are best enjoyed poolside.
